The Use of Chemical Abortion is on the Rise

Pro-Life, Pro-Child, Pro-Family

Abortion is not a “reproductive right” as has been falsely presented by many medical professionals, Planned Parenthood, and even judges.

First, it must be said that once a child has been conceived, reproduction has *already occurred*, and therefore, what follows are decisions about what will now happen to that new human being.

From the moment we are each conceived, a unique and distinct life has begun; a life that is protected under our Constitution which clearly states we each are entitled to *“life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness”*.

Taking the life of a child in the womb is nothing short of intentional murder.

Sadly, more than 1 million abortions, 1,026,700 to be precise, were provided in the U.S. in 2023 and approximately 63%* of that total were chemical abortions. That's a major finding from a report published by the Guttmacher Institute, a research organization which supports access to abortion.

The report went on to say that in 2021 (the most recent year with available data), **40% of facilities known to provide abortion care offered only medication abortion**. And, starting in 2021, the FDA lifted medically unnecessary restrictions that had required in-person provision of mifepristone. That regulation change, which the FDA finalized in January 2023, meant that health care providers and online pharmacies could mail abortion medication to patients, including those who live far from a provider or are otherwise unable to make an in-person visit.

The number of US providers offering a telemedicine consultation—by video, phone call, text or online platform—and mailing abortion pills increased from 7% of all providers known to offer medication abortion in 2020 to 31% in 2022. Online-only clinics, after first appearing as a new type of abortion provider in 2021, accounted for 8% of all abortions provided within the formal health care system in the first six months of 2023.

In addition to honoring the mission to pray in front of Planned Parenthood in Helena for the duration of the 40 days spring campaign, Prolife Montana will be specifically focusing on providing information and education regarding the **abortion pill** as well as **adoption agencies** here in Montana.

The need is great to better educate our communities about the growing safety threat abortion poses spiritually, physically, and emotionally, especially chemical abortion. If you visit plannedparenthood.org, you quickly realize exactly why Steve Karlin stated in the **Winter 2024-2025 Day 41 magazine article**, “*A Bitter Pill to Swallow*”:

“pill induced abortions mean increased carnage, accelerated regret.”

With very little effort by visitors to their website, Planned Parenthood provides a mother with contact information for 5 Abortion clinics in Montana and 16 virtual tele-health providers through an “abortionfinder” link. This website states that chemical abortion may be distributed up **through 13 weeks** even though the FDA has only approved it through 10 weeks of pregnancy. At 13 weeks, the baby is approximately 2.9 inches or about the size of a lemon.

This is not compassionate healthcare, but it is a lucrative business for abortion providers since the average cost of a chemical abortion is \$800 and does not require the costly overhead expenses of surgical abortions.

Please plan to join us on the sidewalk for our Kickoff Rally on Wednesday, March 5, at Planned Parenthood Helena from 3pm-5pm when we will walk down to Euclid Ave. to hold signs stating the value of all lives. We will follow that up on Saturday, March 8, with another educational sign event on the corners of N. Montana and Custer Ave. from 11am—1pm.

Our Mid Rally will be starting at 3:00pm on March 22 at the Helena Knights of Columbus, 1867 Washington St. A light lunch will be served, and we will have adoption organizations on site to provide information about their services as well as a presentation on chemical abortion. Please invite friends and family to attend to learn more about these important topics. **This will also be a DIAPER DRIVE for the Baby Boutique at Catholic Social Services.** The past two years they have handed out 80,000 diapers (each year)! Please bring a package of diapers with you or send a check to Prolife Montana (P.O. Box 6924, Helena, 59604) and designate “CSSM diaper drive” in the subject line.

Our Closing Rally will be on Saturday, April 12, from 11am—1pm on N. Montana Ave. and 11th Ave. in front of CVS and Walgreens. We will be holding signs to bring awareness to the potential of brick and mortar pharmacy distribution of the abortion pill.

Trailhead Christian Fellowship Church in Townsend recently launched a ministry/small group called **Embrace Grace**. This group provides emotional, practical, and spiritual support for young single pregnant women who find themselves in an unexpected pregnancy.

The primary goal of Embrace Grace is to empower the church to be a safe and nonjudgmental place for these young women to turn to when they discover they are pregnant. It is a 12-week program that focuses on God's love and grace. Upon completion of the 12 week program, the mother-to-be is given a baby shower to honor her courageous decision to have her child.

The team of pro-love leaders at Trailhead Christian Fellowship offer practical help to brave girls who need essential baby items, transportation, childcare, and meals. Is ABORTION GENOCIDE?

The Political Instability Task Force estimated that 43 genocides occurred between 1956 and 2016, resulting in 50 million deaths.

The United Nations Adopted Resolution 260 (III) A of the U.N. General Assembly on 9 December 1948 and was entered into force January 12, 1951.

Article II of this Adopted Resolution reads: In the present Convention, genocide means any of the following acts committed with intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, ethnical, racial or religious group, as such:

- Killing members of the group;
- Causing serious bodily or mental harm to members of the group;
- Deliberately inflicting on the group conditions of life calculated to bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part;**
- Imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group;
- Forcibly transferring children of the group to another group.

According to the World Health Organization (WHO), every year in the world there are approximately 73 million induced abortions. This corresponds to approximately **200,000 abortions per day**.
