



Despite the fact the FDA is still conducting a safety review of the abortion pill and recent research conducted by the Ethics Public Policy Center suggests that nearly 11% of women who take mifepristone experience at least one serious complication within 45 days of taking this medication, many college campuses are now making this medication available on campus. In fact, California, Illinois, Massachusetts, and New York have mandated abortion pill availability on campus and other states, including Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, and Vermont require college campuses to offer assistance with, access to, and referrals for abortions.

Nearly 84% of abortions performed in Montana are chemical abortions.
That is nearly 20% above the national average of 65%.

For women seeking the abortion pill online via telehealth appointments, the deception and lies used to disseminate these pills is obvious. They are often delivered in handwritten envelopes with deceptive return addresses. Instructions are sent separately by email and instruct women to LIE to their doctor if they are among the high number of women who need to seek medical care during or after their abortion.

This does not look anything like authentic healthcare. In fact, it looks more like an industry and ideology that does not care about women's health and safety.

The affiliate added that "PPGNHAIAK joins a growing number of sexual and reproductive health care providers offering this model of care."

Prolife Montana Billboard Project Update

Prolife Montana has partnered with the attorneys with abortioninjury.com to let Montana women who were harmed by abortion know they may have a legal avenue to pursue possible compensation. Our first billboard will be up in Billings the first week in June. The billboard we are renting is THE most viewed billboard in the Billings area. Our second billboard will go up on July 6 in Helena on the corner of Euclid Ave. and Lincoln St. Those leaving Planned Parenthood Helena will see this sign. Our goal is to place one billboard in Montana's six major cities, BUT WE NEED YOUR HELP TO DO THAT! Renting billboards is not cheap, and in order to get the first right of refusal, we need to rent the billboard for a full year. From the Medicaid claims we received from the Department of Public Health and Human Services as a result of our FOIA request, we know there have been emergency room visits to a number of hospitals in Montana for complications of abortions.
